

## EAP Schedule 2019

EAP will run for twelve weeks followed by a one-week break. Students will be permitted to enter from week one to eight. Enrollment will close from week nine to twelve.

### Admission Requirements

The minimum level required to enter EAP one is Low Intermediate Step. Students will be required to submit a handwritten assignment before they enter the class.

- 8 writing assignments, 8 presentations, 8 quizzes per term
