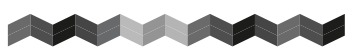

admission process

The admission process includes the following steps:

- A student or their representative sends completed registration form to IH
- IH checks availability of the course and if admission criteria are fulfilled and responds if any clarification of enrollment detail is required
- If there is a minimum level required for the course, IH will ask for credentials to prove the student's level of English. If no sufficient credentials are available, IH may ask the student to complete the IH online test. If the test does not come up with a clear result or there are any doubts about the level, IH may conduct further assessment via a skype or telephone interview.
- If the student can be accepted into the program, IH sends the invoice(s) and a confirmation email to the student or/and their representative together with the student contract and a link to the IH policies. The student will be required to sign the contract and to return it to IH before the start of the course.
- Payment needs to be made: Non-refundable registration placement fees are due at the time of registration with the balance due at least 21 days prior to the start of your course.

Acceptable forms of payment include:

Bank Transfer, Bank Draft, Money Order, Canadian Cheque, Visa, Master Card, AMEX, JCB, Interac, Cash or Union Pay. (\$2% surcharge for credit card payments, \$5000 limit for credit card payments)

All bank charges must be paid by the payer.

- IH will send out the Letter of Acceptance and arranges extra services as required (accommodation, airport transfer, medical insurance) and sends out the details at least 21 days before the course starts but only after agreed payment has been received.

refund & cancellation policies

IH VANCOUVER REFUND & CANCELLATION POLICY

- If IH receives tuition from the student, or a person on behalf of the student, IH will refund the student, or the person who paid on behalf of the student, the tuition that was paid in relation to the program in which the student is enrolled if:
 - IH receives a notice of withdrawal in writing from the student no later than seven days after the effective contract date (confirmation date) and before the contract start date (course start date);
 - the student, or the student's parent or legal guardian, signs the student enrolment contract seven days or less before the contract start date and IH receives a notice of withdrawal from the student between the date the student, or the student's parent or legal guardian, signed the student enrolment contract and the contract start date (course start date).
 - IH will refund the tuition for the program and all related fees paid by the student or a person on behalf of the student enrolled in the program if the student is enrolled in the program without having met the admission requirements and did not misrepresent his or her knowledge or skills when applying for admission.
 - Except in the case of a program provided solely through distance education, if no written notice is received and if a student does not attend any of the first 30% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term, IH may retain up to 50% of the tuition paid under the student enrolment contract.
 - Except in the case of a program provided solely through distance education, if IH receives a notice of withdrawal from a student:
 - more than seven days after the effective contract date (confirmation date) and:
 - at least 30 days before the contract start date (course start date), IH may retain up to 10% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract, to a maximum of \$1,000.
 - less than 30 days before the contract start date (course start date), IH may retain up to 20% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract, to a maximum of \$1,300.
 - after the contract start date (confirmation date):
 - but before 11% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term have been provided, IH may retain up to 30% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract.
 - and after 10% but before 30% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term have been provided, IH may retain up to 50% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract.
 - If IH provides a notice of dismissal to a student and the date IH delivers the notice to the student is:
 - before 11% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term have been provided, IH may retain up to 30% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract.
 - after 10% but before 30% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term have been provided, IH may retain up to 50% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract
 - after completing 30% of the hours of instruction to be provided during the contract term have been provided, no refund is due under the student enrolment contract.
 - For programs provided solely through distance education, if IH receives a notice of withdrawal from a student, or if IH delivers a notice of dismissal to a student after the contract start date:
 - Up to and including completion of, and receiving evaluation on 30% of the program, IH may retain up to 30% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract;
 - Up to and including completion of, and receiving evaluation on 50% of the program, IH may retain up to 50% of the tuition due under the student enrolment contract.
 - The institution will not refund the following fees paid in relation to the program in which the student is enrolled:
 - administrative fees,
 - application/registration fees,
 - assessment fees,
 - fees charged for textbooks or other course materials, including equipment and uniforms, and any other fees prescribed by the Private Training Act.
 - IH will refund fees charged for course materials paid for but not received if the student provides a notice of withdrawal to IH or IH provides a notice of dismissal to the student.
 - Refunds required under this policy will be paid to the student, or a person who paid the tuition or fees on behalf of the student, within 30 days:
 - of the date IH receives a student's notice of withdrawal;
 - of the date IH provides a notice of dismissal to the student;
 - of the date that the registrar provides notice to IH that IH is not complying with section 2 of this policy; or
 - after the first 30% of the hours of instruction if section 3 of this policy applies.
- If an international student delivers a copy of a refusal of a study permit to the institution, sections 1(a), 1(b), 4, 7, and 8 of this policy apply as if the copy of the refusal were a notice of withdrawal, unless the international student requests an additional letter of acceptance

Note: Programs of study may not be downgraded once they have commenced. Program upgrades are based on availability and may or may not be possible.

Housing

- Housing Cancellation Policy before arrival
 - Accommodation placement fee is non-refundable
 - If a student cancels 3 weeks or more before the arrival date, no cancellation fee will be charged
 - If a student cancels less than 3 weeks before the arrival date, 1 week of housing will be charged
 - If a student cancels less than 1 week before the arrival date or is a no-show, 2 weeks of housing will be charged
- Housing Cancellation Policy after arrival
 - Students registered for one month or less of housing must give the Housing Director TWO weeks notice.
 - Students registered for more than one month of housing, must give the Housing Director ONE month notice.
 - If there is a serious problem with the host family that requires an immediate move, the Housing Director will assist in finding a new family at no extra cost.
 - As long as there is a valid reason for wanting to change to a new family, there will be no charge for a new homestay placement. However, if a student chooses to change accommodation for his/her own reasons, there will be a charge for the new placement.

Note: *The Placement fee is non-refundable.

***There is no refund available for missed meals in Homestay.**
