Ministerial Representatives from Federal and Provincial Governments

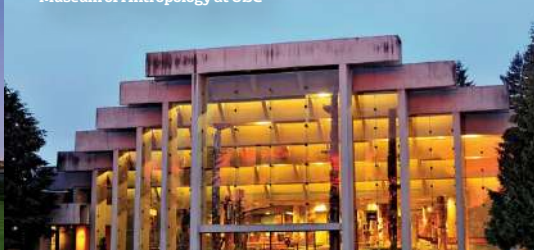
